One of Fox Valley Reading Council's Community Projects!

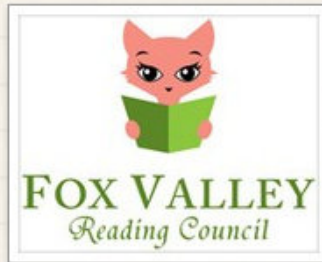

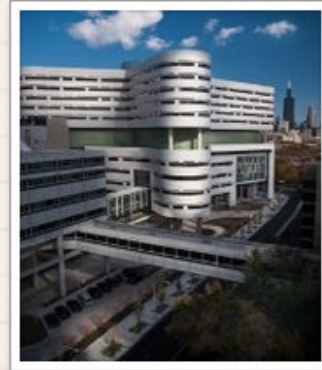

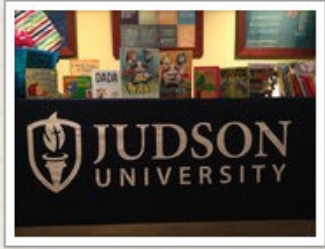
