The *Prairie State Award for Excellence in Writing for Children* recognizes an Illinois children's/young adult author whose body of work demonstrates excellence, engenders a love of literature, and embraces an important part of the mission of the Illinois Reading Council – to promote lifelong literacy.

CRITERIA

- 1. Nominees shall have resided in Illinois for a minimum of five years and be residing in the state at the time of nomination.
- 2. Nominees must have:
 - Authored a minimum of five books published for children/young adults (books currently out-of-print can be included).
 - Resided in Illinois for a minimum of five years and be residing in the State at the time of the nomination.
- 3. Nominees shall have exhibited an interest and willingness to become involved with young people through appearances in appropriate settings.
- 4. Nominee's body of work shall offer readers the opportunity to delight in, reflect upon, and/or make connections with their world.
- 5. Nominee's body of work has earned the respect of the children's literature community.
