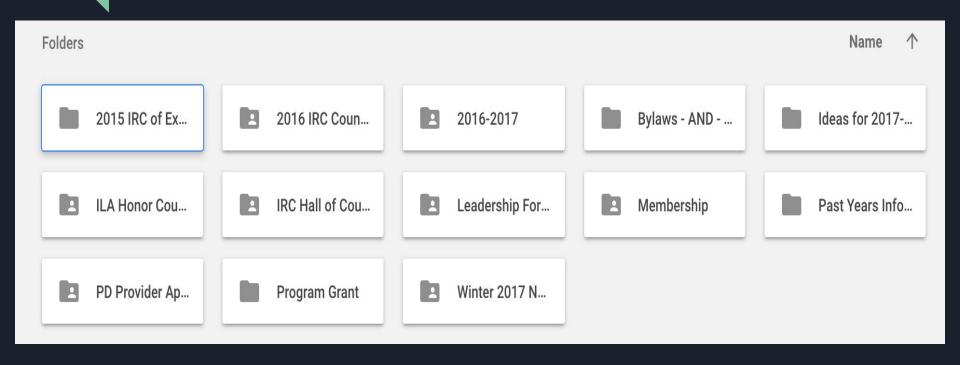



Why Use Social Media

Many teachers do not use email

Different ages use different social media tools

We want to reach as many people as possible

 Post often using all tools to reach as many different people as possible

Facebook

- Create a Facebook Page <u>Directions</u>
- Like the <u>IRC Facebook Page</u> <u>Illinois Reads</u>
 <u>Facebook Page</u>
- Search for other councils to "like"
- Send out announcements or other information frequently
- Schedule posts ahead of time



PARC

PARC's Facebook Page

- Promoting upcoming events
- Share the link to newsletters
- Share the link to registration for events
- Link to other councils' events
- Show how to add a post

Twitter

- Create a Twitter Account
- Follow <u>IRC</u>
- Use the hashtag #IRCreads
- Use common hashtags that correspond to your events such as #tlap, #edtech (<u>list of common hashtags</u>)
- Using a third party app, such as Tweetdeck, you can schedule posts ahead of time

Instagram

Share photos - <u>ILA IRC</u>

 Link to Facebook and Twitter automatically

YouTube

- Share videos ILA
- Most popular form of social media
- Great form of communication
- Council Clips

Create a Website

- Use Google Sites Illinois Reads
- Use Weebly <u>SCIRA</u>
- Include all of your newsletters and event registrations etc.

Council Communication

- Check your <u>IRC Council Webpage</u> to update social media links (tell Carrie)
- Send Carrie your newsletter and links
- Tell Carrie if any of your events change date, place or time
- <u>Photo Release</u> for permission to post pictures of people at your events
